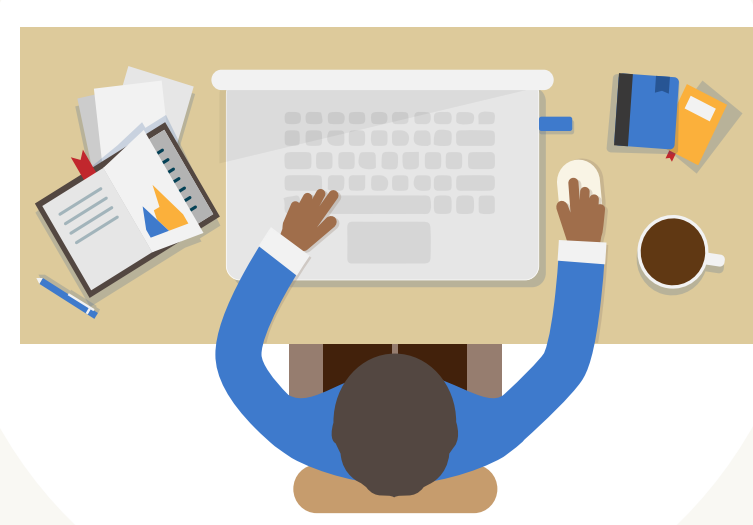

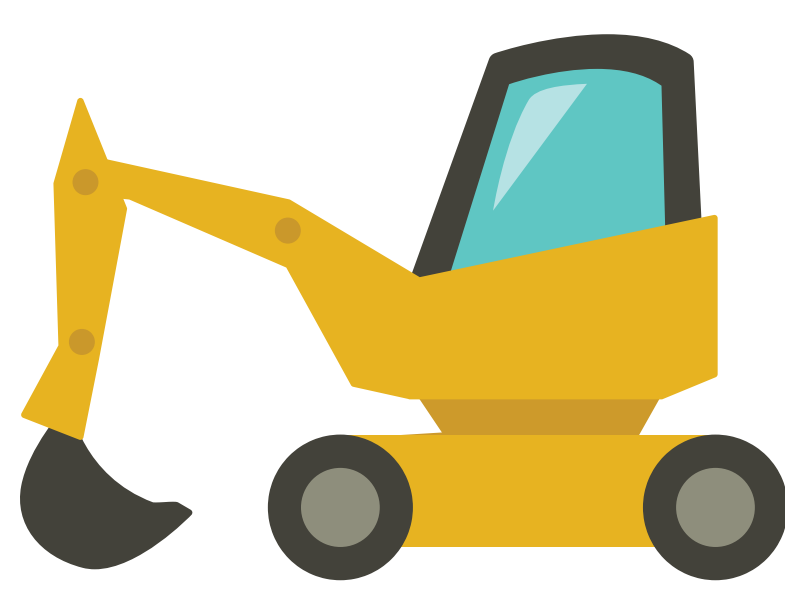
PINKY PROMISE?

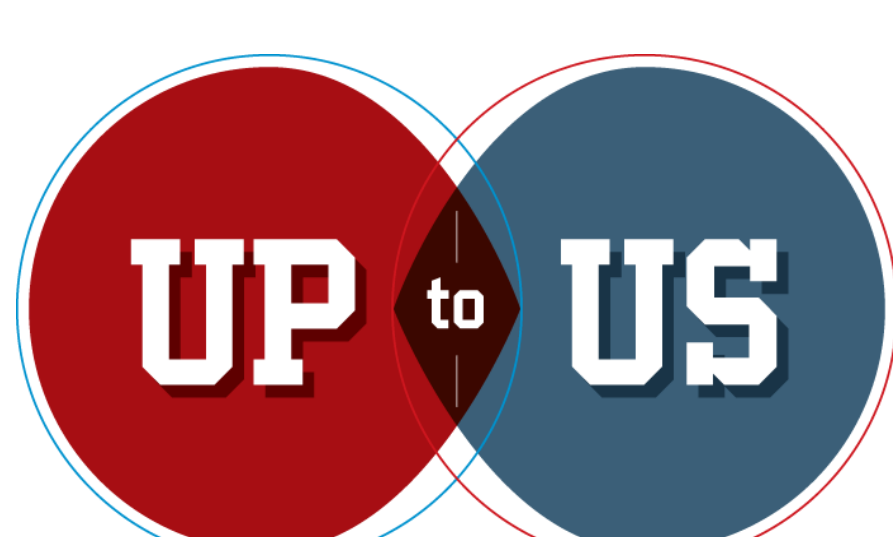
- Immigration and the proposed travel-ban
